

Article 303.07 Littering

No person shall deposit any litter which is defined as all waste material, including, but not limited to, any garbage, refuse, trash, disposable package, container, can, bottle, paper, covered electronic devices, ashes, cigarette or cigar butt, flammable material, carcass of any dead animal or any part thereof or any other materials offensive, unsightly, or dangerous to public health on any premises or roads within the Town. This does not include the wastes of primary processes of mining, logging, sawmilling, farming or manufacturing. It shall be the responsibility of any violator to remove such matter immediately. The fine shall be no more than \$500 according to the amount of material littered, and court costs.

Article 527.19 Distracted Driving

No person shall drive a motorized vehicle and utilize handheld cell phones for texting, writing or reading while said vehicle is in motion. The fine for the first offense is \$100, the second offense \$200, and third offense \$300. All fines will have court costs added. Beginning July 1, 2013, the use of handheld phones for verbal conversation while driving a motorized vehicle, which it is in motion, will have the same penalties.

Article 213.05 Simple Possession of Illegal Substances

No person shall possess a controlled substance unless the substance was obtained directly from or pursuant to, a valid prescription or order of a medical practitioner while acting in the course of his professional practice. Any person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor. Any first offense for possession of Synthetic Cannabinoids, 3,4-methylenedioxypropylvalerone MPVD, and/or mephedrone or less than 15 grams of Marijuana (all of which are defined in the West Virginia Code 60A-1-101) shall be no more than \$500 plus court costs.
