The Athens Town Council met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 18, 2015 in the Athens Town Hall.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

The Council approved the August 4, 2015, minutes without objection.

**CITIZENS INPUT**

**EMPLOYEE REPORTS QUARTERLY DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS - OFFICE:** No Departments appeared before Council.

**OLD BUSINESS**

- Standing Committees and Commissions – Mayor Pike will continue to examine committee membership.

- Second and final reading of the proposed changes to the following Ordinances were approved by Council on a motion by White and second by Lilly.
- The ordinance changes are as follows:

405.02 Business Service Fee - ~~\$30.00~~ \$45.00

405.03 Out of Town Garbage – ~~\$13.50~~ \$16.50

405.04 Special Garbage Pick-up - ~~\$35~~ \$45

405.05(B) Building Replacement fee- This \$1.50 per month fee will not be collected at the present time.

405.06 Asset Replacement Fee - ~~\$1.00~~ \$3.00 per month exclusively for vehicle acquisition and/or building construction.

405.07 Yard/Garage Sale Fee – Added to the end of the first sentence “...excludes Town sponsored yard sale days”.

405.08 Special fees

(A) Reservation of Town park Gazebo- \$20.00 per day

(B) Bill Reprint Fee \$1.00

(C) Fee to Pick-Up Garbage at the Door – Only available to those with handicaps or the elderly. \$2.50 per month

(D) Dumpster fee \$20.00 per month (in addition to the \$45.00 per month Business Service Fee).

**NEW BUSINESS**

- Town Social – Invitation – Council discussed the Town Social including the Town Social history and finances.
